NARTE, in affiliation with ARRL (The American Radio Relay League) has registered a High Frequency (HF) Amateur Radio Net called "The NARTE Net". The NARTE Net sessions open a forum for the common interests of ARRL members and NARTE Certified professionals. All Amateur Radio Operators are welcome to check in.

The NARTE Net times are as follows:

Saturdays at 1700 UTC at Frequency 18.1400 MHz

Sundays at 2100 UTC at Frequency 18.1400 MHz

The NARTE Net is launched to further the mutual support of ARRL and NARTE in fostering technical awareness, educating and providing credentials to practitioners in amateur and commercial telecommunications.

NARTE is a worldwide, non-profit, professional organization which certifies professional engineers and technicians in the fields of Telecommunications and Unlicensed Wireless Systems Installation. Candidates are evaluated by verifiable measures including, as appropriate, examination, experiential and educational background and reputation for unquestioned competency within their specified expertise.
